## 2018 LEARNING GOALS FOR MY CHILD

As part of the “Getting To Know You” interviews this year, we are looking forward to working closely with you to set learning and social and emotional goals for your child. Goal setting was an important part of learning at Giralang Primary School last year and will continue to have a highly visible presence in classrooms in 2018. We invite you to have a think about what you would like your child to achieve this year and record some goals on this form to share during the “Getting To Know You” interview.

A good learning goal should provide a reasonable level of challenge while still being achievable within a given timeframe. The **SMART** model is a useful tool for setting goals. Using this model, a good goal should be Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relevant and Timely.

The SMART model can help take a broad aim for learning and turn it into something individualised for your child. For example, if you would like your child to improve at reading, a suitable SMART goal might be:

Academic areas for development	Agreed student SMART goals
Reading	<i>By the end of the term, establish a home reading routine so that my child reads for 20 minutes at least 4 nights a week.</i>
