As part of this term's History unit, Year 2 will be visiting the Hall School and Museum. The purpose of this visit is to observe how schooling, farming and technology have changed over the past 100 years.

Date: Tuesday 15 May 2018
Time: Depart school at 9:15am and return by 12pm
Location: Hall School and Museum, Victoria Street, Hall
Travel: Bus
Cost: \$6.00 for entry fee and bus

Over the course of the morning, students will participate in activities popular during the 1940s. To fully embrace the experience, students are encouraged to dress in period costumes of 1940's children (see examples on the reverse side of this note). We understand dressing up may not be possible and normal school uniform is also appropriate for the day.

Students attending the excursion will need to wear and bring:

- school uniform with comfortable walking shoes and socks and a warm jacket or jumper;
- a healthy recess packed as normal in their school bags; and
- a labelled drink bottle filled with water.
