On the Wednesday and Thursday of 'Week 0', all staff joined with our colleagues from Southern Cross Early Childhood School for professional learning. Day one centred on deepening our Cultural Integrity. Our facilitators for the day were Dr Red Ruby Scarlet and Jessica Staines. Some key takeaways were:

SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATIONS 2019

CARPARK SAFETY

Parents and carers are asked to take particular care in the school carpark. There have been increasing incidences, reported to the school, of community members not adhering to the school crossing signs, and driving through them when students are attempting to cross the road.

For pedestrian safety, parents and carers are asked not to use the footpath at the school crossing signs to drive onto the grass and park under trees.

Parents and carers are asked to please observe the 'no stopping' signs in the carpark. If cars are parked illegally, it is difficult for other cars and large vehicles to pass. When collecting students from After School Care, parents and carers are asked to park in car parking spots, and not along the curb. Curb parking also makes it difficult for other cars to pass.

PARKING IN THE BUS ZONE

Parents and carers are asked not to park in the bus zone on Canopus Crescent. A number of students catch the bus home from school, and cars obstruct the view of bus drivers, who have driven past students. Also, buses cannot stop to pick up students when cars are parked in the bus zone. Your assistance in this matter is most appreciated.

LATE ARRIVALS AND EARLY DEPARTURES

If your child arrives at school after 9:10am, they are required to be signed in by an adult at the Front Office. A slip will be given to the student to hand to their classroom teacher.

Similarly, if your child leaves school early, a parent/carer must approach the Front Office to receive a slip to hand to the classroom teacher. The teacher will then release your child into your care.

If your child is absent for the whole school day, please notify the Front Office on 6142 2630. When your child returns to school, please provide a note in writing with the reason for their absence.
